## Listen:

Ask: Tell us your best “fishy” story....real fish!

## Learn:

Read Mark 1:16-20

- What was Jesus doing? Hint: Prior to this incident...how many followers did Jesus have?
- What kind of follower do you think Jesus was looking to call?
- From what you know about Simon, Andrew, James and John...what kind of men did Jesus call? Give specific details from Scripture about these men.
- What does it mean to be a “fisher of men”?

Read John 1:40-44

- The gospel of John’s account of the calling of Peter seems to differ from the gospel of Mark or does it? Discuss it.
- What does this difference seem to suggest? Hint: Could Jesus have met Peter prior to the call in Mark 1:16-20?

Read the following “follow me” passages:

- Matthew 8:22
- Matthew 9:9
- Matthew 19:21-24
- Does everyone Jesus calls follow Him?
- Name some things that keep people from following Jesus.

Read the following “follow me” passages:

- Compare Mark 8:34 and Luke 9:23. Discuss briefly what it takes to follow Jesus.
- Read John 10:27. What must happen before we can follow Jesus?
- How do you “hear His voice”?

Read John 21:19-22

- Discuss this interesting passage and the use of “follow me”.

**Live:**

- On a scale of 1-10, ten being just like Jesus....how well are you following Him?
- On a scale of 1-10, ten being I catch a fish everyday, how well are you “fishing for men”?
